

T2A TRANSITION TO ADULTHOOD PATHWAY

The T2A Pathway is a framework to illustrate 10 stages in the criminal justice process at which effective interventions can be made to help young adults desist from crime. These include policing and arrest, sentencing and custody.

To build upon the work of the previous T2A pilots, six projects have been selected across England that will operate at different stages of the T2A Pathway, illustrating how a 'whole pathway approach' for young adults could be commissioned in a given locality.
